Following the success of last year's entertaining "Call My Bluff" tasting, we decided to start the year with a similar fun session of top wines tasted "blind". Our vice-chairman, Bill Boyle, will lead us through ten wines where the main question is "Do I like this wine?", with the second question "Why?". Our tastes vary, but it is easy to be influenced by wine critics, awards, or labels and price. So tasting blind eliminates any bias and you learn more about the wines you like most. A variety of wines will be tasted, most having earned accolades from major international tastings.

Six of our wines are from Italy, Spain and France, representing the Old World, which we will contrast with other wines from the New World. The wines' prices vary from £8 to £16, representing good quality without busting the bank. Blends are outlawed – so we can concentrate on grape varieties. We will have lots of clues for those who wish to guess – but mainly we will judge together the best of the tasting. The wines are all accessible, mainly from Waitrose, so you can add your favourite of the night to your shopping list.

The tasting will be followed by a generous selection of finger food from M&S, with a quaffing wine.
